CSC Badges

Lunches	will be served from	12:30 until	14:00 in Cavendish room – 1st floor - Hamilton Centre

During tuition periods, coffees and drinks will be served on the 3rd floor of the Lecture/Exercise rooms building, room #362.

The Opening Ceremony will take place in **Howell Theatre** in the **Howell Building** (Zone D) at **09:00**.

Computers for exercises

The exercise room is provided with computers for each pair of students. **Only these computers can** be used for exercises and may be connected to the exercise room wired network. They will have Internet access.

Access to the Exercises Room

Please note that outside tuition hours, the rooms will be locked. You will be able to access to it with the Brunel University Access Card that you received on the registration day.
